## Wireless Set Top Box Self Installation Guide



- 1. Place the Set Top Box near your TV and at least six feet away from the ALLO router.
- 2. Connect your TV to your Set Top Box. In most cases, an HDMI cable is utilized, circled in blue. Otherwise, you can use component cables with the corresponding color-match ports.



- **3.** Connect your Set Top Box to a power source.
- **4.** Three dots will appear on your screen, followed by a "Connect?" message.

- 5. Go to your ALLO router and press the WPS button three times. The WPS light on the ALLO Router will turn amber.

- 6. Press the "OK" button on your Set Top Box or remote.

This needs to be completed within two minutes of performing step five.

7. A green light on your Set Top Box means you have paired successfully. It may take several minutes before live TV appears. Repeat these steps for each additional Set Top Box.

Important: To ensure proper signal strength, there should be at least three LED green bars lit up on the Set Top Box. If you're seeing fewer bars, try moving the Set Top Box. Example: Remove it from the entertainment center, or out from behind the TV.



Follow the instructions on the back of your remote to program it to your TV.
